



## VOICEMAIL REMINDER PHONE SCRIPTS

### **For General Use, as Appropriate:**

We want to make sure your family is protected against a contagious infection and cause of meningitis called meningococcal disease. The CDC and this office recommend meningococcal vaccination for all adolescents 11 through 18 to help them avoid this rare, but dangerous infection.

Please leave a message and someone from our office will call back during normal office hours to schedule an appointment for you or your child. [Alternate: Please call back during normal office hours and ask about scheduling an appointment for vaccination.]

### **For Use During The Winter “Peak” Months, As Appropriate:**

Winter is here and it’s a good time to think about vaccines your children may need. For example, adolescents need to be vaccinated against meningococcal disease, which causes meningitis and blood infection. The CDC and this office recommend meningococcal vaccination for all adolescents 11 through 18 to help them avoid this rare, but dangerous infection.
